- Fuel Source (Propane and Battery)
- Written Test

### ***Practical Evaluation:***

- *Pre-operational Check*
- *Start-up and Shutdown*
- *General operational skills evaluation based on turning (pivot point), driving forward/reverse, driving with obstructed view and pedestrian awareness.*
- *Load handling. Securing loads and proper placement.*
- *Fuel Source (Battery/Propane)*
